From the ICT Department

At this half way point in the year it's a good opportunity for students and parents to reflect on students' achievements and plan for the time ahead.

A few tips to help in all areas:

- Pack and prepare your school bag with correct files and work for the next day.
- ring pens and other necessary stationery.
- Look after handouts and notes from class.
- Keep track of due dates for assessments and homework.
- Read over handouts, photocopies, notes and text prior to the next lesson.
- Hand in work on time, complete to at least a satisfactory level.
- REMEMBER: removable media e.g. USBs are not allowed. USE MOODLE.
- Use the ICT facilities at lunchtime to catch up.

EXAMS

This year ALL Upper School (computing) ICT subjects will have final exams. For Year 12s, this means that Applied Information Technology Stage 1 (VET students) and Stage 3 students will attend exams during the Term 3 holidays. Failure to attend will negatively influence their grades. These exams are supervised by external staff and suitable ID and Curriculum Council number is essential.

SOCIAL NETWORKING SITES

Several news items recently highlighted the devastating impact of cyber bullying. The Year 11 group will be attending a cyber bullying workshop in September. Parents are asked to monitor home use and emphasise the impacts of this with their child. At school, students are not permitted to use sites such as Twitter or Facebook.

COPYRIGHT AND THE INTERNET

The perception of many students is that if images, information, music or videos are available on the internet they can be copied or reproduced at will. The Legislation that covers copyright of digital material is the Copyright Act (Australia) of 1968 with subsequent amendments to reflect the changes to styles of media and reproduction.

- Did you know that copyright on material exists 70 years **AFTER** the date of death of the person?

The new courses in ICT stress the importance of understanding the rights and obligations of users and authors. This is particularly relevant in all work places where many organisations have their own IT use policy with very severe penalties and consequences for misuse. A final point to note is that the Australian Federal Police have an ongoing squad for cyber crimes.
