Contributions & Charges Information for Years 7 - 12

CONTRIBUTION & CHARGES

All students of Hampton Senior High School will receive a quality education based on the WA Curriculum.

The School Curriculum and Standards Authority (SCSA: <https://www.scsa.wa.edu.au>) provide additional information about assessment and certification of subjects offered to your child at Hampton Senior High School.

However, we also offer opportunities for your child to enhance their learning journey by offering an array of Specialist and Enrichment programs. There are additional charges for these subjects due to the higher cost of providing these options.

All information for school costs are provided to parents/caregivers two months prior to the school year.

The amount you are required to pay will be based on the subjects your child selects. You may not be required to pay all of these costs, however the requests will not exceed these amounts.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS & VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS



We believe that the best way to provide quality education is through the provision of modern resources and equipment for students. Your payment of the *VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS* will result in improved educational resources, options and support for your child's learning experiences.

CHARGES

Specialist and Enrichment Programs

If you accept a place in our Specialist or Enrichment programs, you will be accepting this *CHARGE*. Full payment should be paid by end Term 1.

Senior Schooling

Year 11 and 12 subjects all have a *CHARGE* attached as per Department of Education policies. All *CHARGES* are compulsory and must be paid in full.

Years 7 to 10

In addition to a curriculum based education program, we offer your child a selection of optional subjects to enrich and explore their educational opportunities. These have an additional *CHARGE* due to the higher cost of providing these options.

Other Optional Charges

These are for voluntary courses and activities where your child elects to participate. These are voluntary but the charge is payable if the student opts to participate. Eg. excursions.

PAYMENTS

We recommend you start making plans now so that you are in a position to pay your compulsory Charges and Voluntary Contributions prior to the end of Term 1. Funds collected within the year are spent on resources for students for that year.

Government Financial Assistance: Secondary Assistance Scheme (SAS)

Applications open during Term 1 only.

The Secondary Assistance Scheme (SAS) from the Commonwealth Government is available to parents/guardians of secondary students that hold a Centrelink Family Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran's Affairs Pensioner (Blue) Concession Card that is current during Term 1.

You will need to bring your card to Admin Services at the start of school to apply.

Education Program Allowance of \$235 for Voluntary Contributions (Year 7 – 10) and Charges (Years 11 & 12)

Clothing Allowance \$115 that can be paid to the school for Charges, or paid to your own bank account.

- *Late applications after Term 1: Department of Education conditions apply.*

- **Payment Plan** – organised by contacting the Hampton Senior High School Finance Officer 6235 7106
- **Centrepay** – regular deductions from your Centrelink payment. Go to **humanservices.gov.au/centrepaybusiness** for more information and to set up your Centrepay deductions.

Please contact Hampton SHS – Admin Services on 6235 7106 as soon as possible if you have any payment issues so we can work with you.

Charges not paid by the end of Term 3 may be referred to a debt collection agency unless arrangements are in place for payments.

Collecting Charges and Voluntary Contributions

Hampton Senior High School will take a positive approach to collecting voluntary contributions from parents/caregivers of students.

With respect to compulsory charges for Years 7 to 12, Hampton Senior High School will actively seek full payment of compulsory charges when appropriate.

Outstanding charges are rolled over to the student's record the following year where applicable, and could accumulate into a substantial amount. For this reason, we encourage early payment each year.

The Hampton Senior High School Board, in support of this process, has endorsed the following actions:

- Statements of your outstanding amounts will be sent out twice a term until cleared.
- Every effort will be made to consult with you to arrange payment to suit your situation.
- Compulsory charges unpaid as at end of Term 3 may be referred to a debt collection agency unless prior arrangements have been made.
