Dear Families,

Hampton Senior High School uses the Learning Management System [SEQTA Learn](#) for our students.

Students use SEQTA Learn to access the following:

- Course information and resources
- Timetable
- Daily lessons and homework
- Notices
- Electronic work submissions
- Direct Messages (internal communication)
- Student dashboard which they can customise with to-do lists, house points, notifications and other features.

In some courses, students can access assessment information and results through SEQTA Learn. All assessment information and results are available to students and parents via Connect.

SEQTA is three-part platform: [SEQTA Teach](#) (staff access), [SEQTA Learn](#) (student access) and [SEQTA Engage](#) (parent/caregiver access).

SEQTA Engage will be available to parents and caregivers from the beginning of Term One. We use SEQTA for online communication to families, so it is important that all families have access. To support parents and caregivers to set up and use SEQTA Engage, we have attached a resource to this email to guide you through setting up and logging into your account. For parents and caregivers who require additional support, you can contact madeline.sinagra@education.wa.edu.au.

FAQ – What do you need to do from here?

1. The school does not have my email address, how will I make an account?

Contact the school via phone or email to provide your email address to the school.

If you have not provided us with your email address, you will not receive an email to allow you to set up your account.

2. The school has my email address, but I do not receive emails from them. Will I receive an email for SEQTA Engage?

No, you won't receive an email. Contact the school via phone or email to ensure your child's student record is ticked to receive email correspondence from Hampton SHS. If you have not indicated that you would like to be a mail recipient, you will not receive an email to allow you to set up your account.

Some families with multiple guardians have only one guardian ticked to receive mail. These families have two options; the guardians can share a SEQTA Engage account, or they can contact the school to both become mail recipients and create their own separate accounts.

3. When can I expect the email to set up my account?

Emails will be sent every week from Thursday February 2. The email may appear in your junk folder, so check there if you do not receive it.

We look forward to working with you to best support our students.
